

SES Leadership Seminars: Onboarding for New Senior Executives Talent Development and Employee Engagement



In this session you will interact with public and private sector leaders as they describe the multiple dividends of identifying and meeting the developmental needs of subordinates, and the talent management frameworks and techniques they use to foster high-performance organizations. Who should attend: Executives in their first or second year in the SES or equivalent.

There will be signage located near the East Tower elevators directing you to the appropriate space.

Directions: The Partnership for Public Service's offices are conveniently located in downtown Washington, DC.

The PPS is located near two Metro stations: Metro Center (Red, Blue and Orange Lines), and Gallery Place/Chinatown (Red, Yellow and Green Lines). Daily garage parking is available in the building for \$17 and is accessible from 12th Street, just past H Street. This is a cash-only garage. There are other public garages in the area as well.
